Ohmsett—The National Oil Spill Response Research & Renewable Energy Test Facility, is the only place where full-scale oil spill response training can be conducted with real oil in a marine environment under controlled conditions.

Located in Leonardo, New Jersey, one hour south of New York City, Ohmsett is maintained and operated by the Department of Interior's Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE), through a contract with MAR, Incorporated.

Think training.

In Ohmsett's 2.6 million gallon test tank, students get hands-on training using the latest spill response equipment and techniques. The tank's wave generator can create different wave types to simulate a variety of harbor, coastal, and marine sea conditions.

Learn about it in the classroom.

Confidence comes from knowing response personnel can handle just about anything that happens during a spill. That's because they have tried it and experienced it at Ohmsett.

Classroom instruction involves a detailed review of oil spill fundamentals and actual implementation of theories during a spill response.

Ohmsett's training facility includes a classroom that can accommodate up to 25 students, with state-of-the-art audio-visual equipment where classroom sessions can complement the tank exercises.

Take it to the tank.

Following classroom instruction, students get hands-on training in the tank. There they practice recovering oil, using real equipment under conditions that simulate an actual oil spill.

- Practice removing spilled oil in waves
- Analyze performance after collecting and measuring recovered oil
- Learn how to recover more oil more efficiently
